**Artificial Darkness** Aug 22 2019 This ambitious study explores how important darkness--artificial darkness--was, as an actual technology, in producing not just photographs but visual novelties and experiments in cinema in the nineteenth century. The study plays out against a backdrop of urban history, where most scholars have focused on the growth of artificial light and the electrification of cities. Elcott's study challenges that approach. We are all aware of the "velvet light trap" in photography, but at the heart of this book are technologies of darkness crucial to cinema that were commonly known as "the black screen," but have, over time, faded from the storied discourse.

In an era of demographic and social change, it looks at the growth of drive-in theatres, the impact of television, the advent of new technologies, the increasing importance of international markets, the Hollywood blacklist, the rise in art house imports and in overseas production, and the eventual demise of the Production Code.
